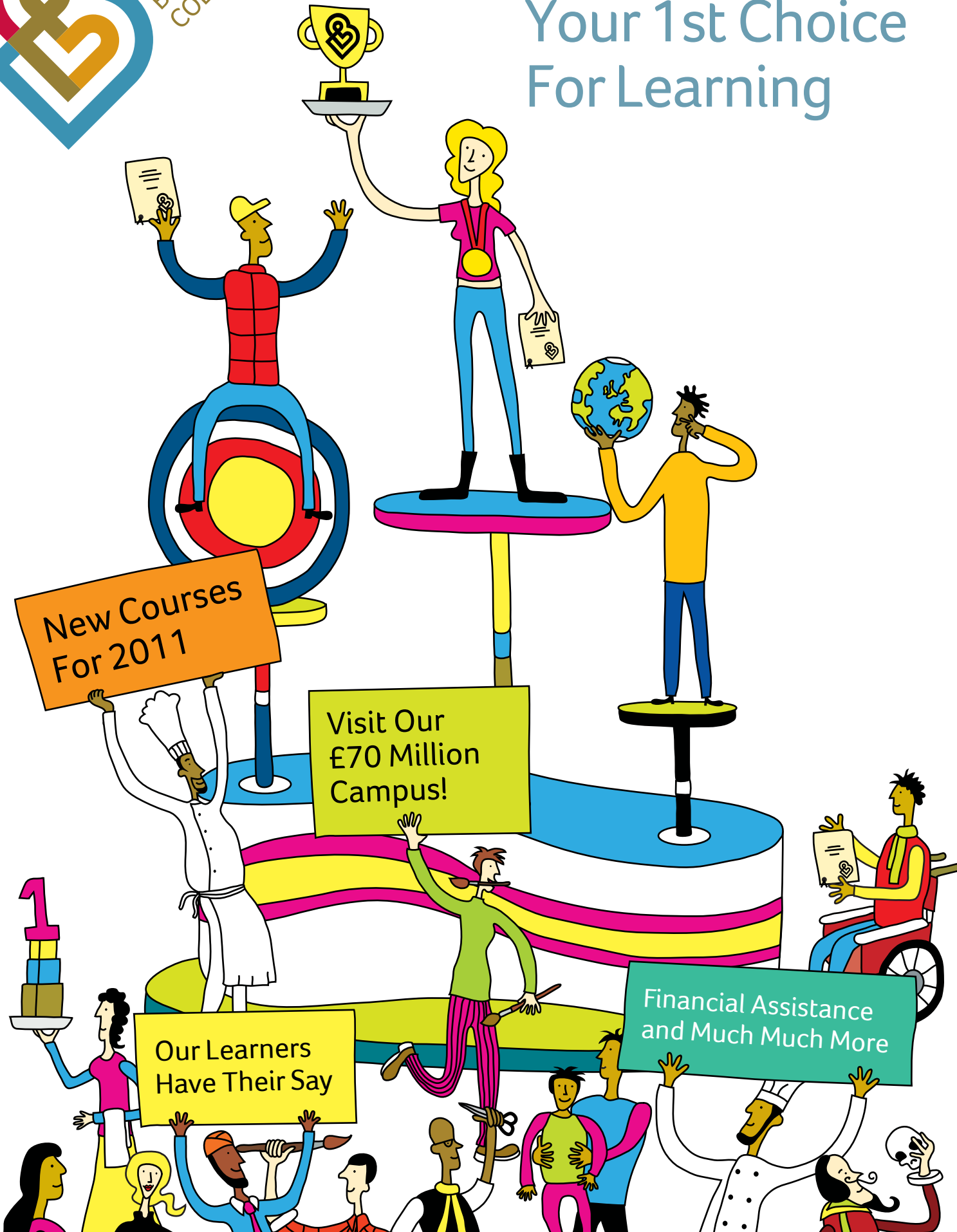

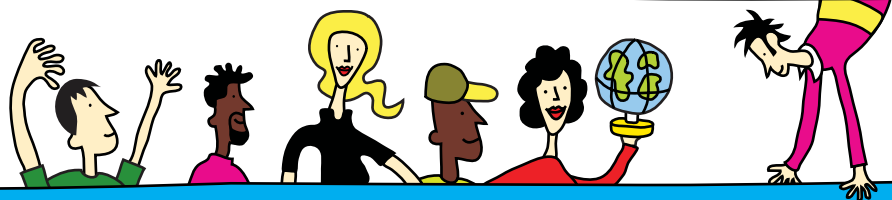


## A-Level Study

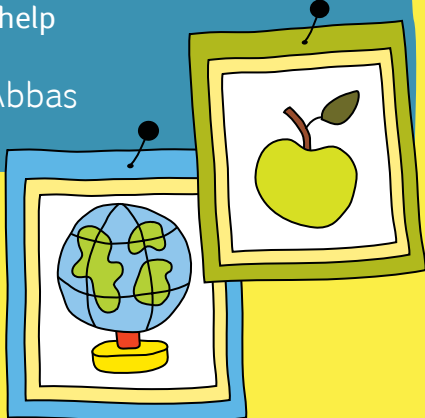

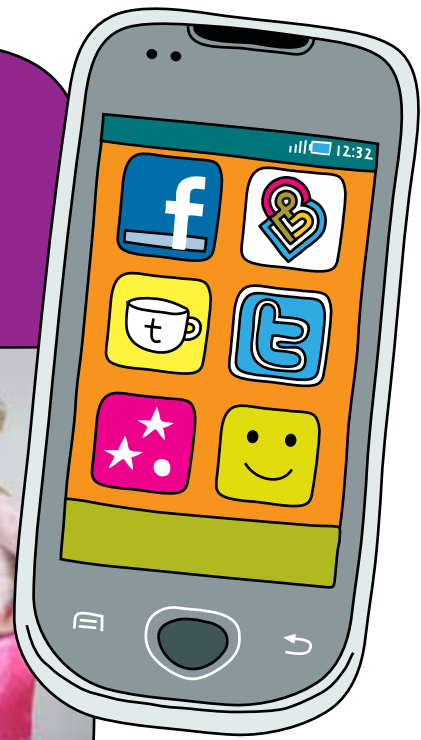
### Bolton College students do something funny for money

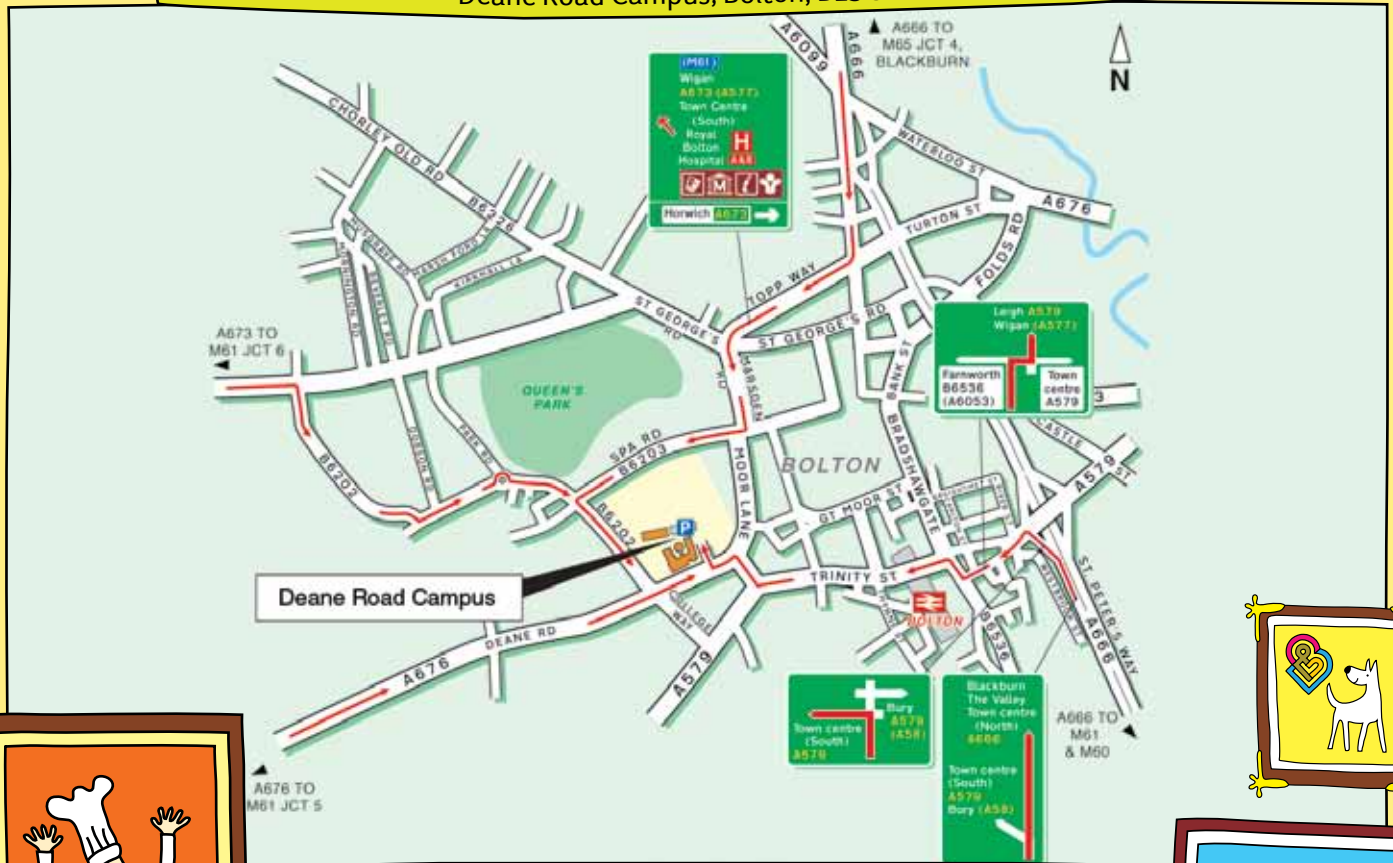


## World Class Partnerships.

## Where are we?

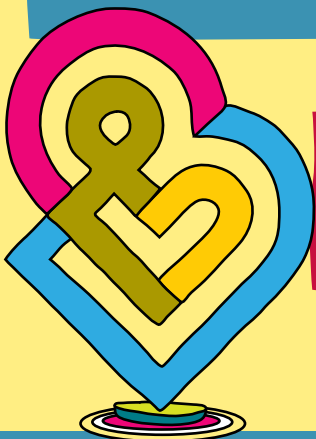


### Trinity Street Bus/Train Terminus –

Exit onto Trinity Street, turn right, at second set of Traffic lights turn right again, at the next set of traffic lights cross over the road at the fire station, turn left onto Deane Road and the main College entrance is 200 Yards along on the right.

### Moor Lane Bus Station –

Exit Bus station turning left onto Moor Lane, heading towards the university and fire station. At traffic lights cross over Moor Lane/Deane Road and you'll find the main entrance to the college 200 yards along on the right.
